**Dead Man's Boots** 11.-  
*A High West original! Named after the boots of one of our patrons. High West Double Rye!, El Jimador Tequila, fresh lime juice, simple syrup, Cock & Bull Ginger Beer*

**High West Lemonade** 9.-  
*Special house lemonade (cinnamon, clove, vanilla, nutmeg concoction) specially made to compliment our whiskeys. High West Double Rye! or High West Vodka 7000', house made lemonade \*POM juice float on the Vodka Lemonade*

**Mint Julep** 11.-  
*The mint julep originated in the southern United States, around the eighteenth century. U.S. Senator Henry Clay of Kentucky introduced the drink to Washington D.C. at the Round Robin Bar in the famous Willard Hotel during his residence in the city. High West Double Rye!, High West Silver Oat Whiskey, mint, simple syrup, served over crushed ice*

**Boston Sour** 10.-  
*What makes a whiskey sour a Boston Sour? A little bit of egg white. We enjoy this classic cocktail up. High West Son of Bourye, lemon juice, powdered sugar, Angostura Bitters, and pasteurized egg white*

**Miner's Sidecar** 10.-  
*The sidecar is often cited as the only good cocktail to come from the prohibition era. Originally made with Cognac, the recipe has evolved over time and is now commonly made with bourbon. Son of Bourye, Grand Marnier, lemon juice, maple syrup*

**Moscow Mule** 9.-  
*The cocktail was invented in 1941 by John G. Martin of G.F. Heublein Brothers, Inc., an East Coast spirits and food distributor, and John "Jack" Morgan, President of Cock 'n' Bull Products (which produce ginger beer) and proprietor of the Cock 'n' Bull Tavern on Sunset Boulevard in Los Angeles. High West Vodka 7000' and Cock 'n' Bull Ginger Beer*

**Peach Mule** 10.-  
*A riff of the classic gin gin mule we replace the gin with our Peach Vodka. High West Peach Vodka, fresh lime juice, ginger syrup, mint leaves and topped with Fentimann's Ginger Soda*

**Vesper** 11.-  
*Bond. James Bond. In Casino Royale, the first book in the Ian Flemming series, this is 007's preferred drink named after his love interest. High West Vodka, Hendricks Gin, Lillet Blonde & Scrappy's Orange Bitters*

**Son of Cider** 11.-  
*During the colonial period, grains did not thrive well and were costly to import. On the other hand, apple orchards were plentiful, making apples cheap and easily obtainable. As a result, hard cider quickly became one of America's most popular beverages. High West Son of Bourye, Calvados Apple Brandy, OMG, vanilla syrup, locally sourced apple cider, served hot*

**Peachy Keen Tea** 11.-  
*This cocktail was created in partnership with our neighbors at Atticus Coffee & Tea House. We think it's a great way to warm up after a day on the slopes. High West Peach Vodka, Angostura bitters, Demarara sugar, lemon slice and orange slice (muddled with bitters and sugar), Atticus Goblet of Fire Black Tea, served hot*
